

4-Day Serengeti & Ngorongoro Safari

Shared departure · Mid-range Lodge

A classic safari focused on spending proper time in the endless plains of the Serengeti, combined with a descent into the Ngorongoro Crater.

Detailed Day-by-Day Itinerary

Day 1 — Arusha → Serengeti National Park

Long driving day | Meals: Lunch, Dinner

Early morning departure from Arusha. The drive passes through the Ngorongoro Conservation Area and its highland landscapes before descending into the Serengeti plains. The journey is long but gradual, with the scenery changing throughout.

The game drive begins on entering the Serengeti in the afternoon. Wildlife sightings often start immediately, with opportunities to see lion, giraffe, elephant, zebra and large herds of wildebeest.

Arrival at camp before sunset.

Overnight: Moyo tented camp, Shuhudia Adventure Camp, Sero tented camp, Heritage Serengeti camp, Engiterata Adventure camp, into the world camp, Tanzania bush camp, Serengeti Wild Camp, Serengeti Wildebeest Camp or Baobab Central Camp (depends on availability)

Day 2 — Full Day in the Serengeti

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

A full day of game driving in the Serengeti, departing early in the morning when wildlife is most active. The day is spent exploring different areas of the park depending on animal movement.

The Serengeti offers some of the most consistent wildlife viewing in Africa, especially for predators. It is also where the large herds move across the plains throughout the year.

Game drives continue through the morning and afternoon with a break for lunch. Return to camp in the evening.

Overnight: Moyo tented camp, Shuhudia Adventure Camp, Sero tented camp, Heritage Serengeti camp, Engiterata Adventure camp, into the world camp, Tanzania bush camp, Serengeti Wild Camp, Serengeti Wildebeest Camp or Baobab Central Camp (depends on availability)

Day 3 — Serengeti → Ngorongoro Highlands

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

An early morning game drive in the Serengeti. After breakfast, a final game drive continues before exiting the park in the afternoon.

The drive then heads toward the Ngorongoro Conservation Area, ascending into cooler highland terrain. Arrival near the crater rim by late afternoon.

Overnight: Ngorongoro Wild Camp, Ngorongoro safari lodge, Mysigio Camp, Tanzania Bush Camp (depends on availability)

Day 4 — Ngorongoro Crater → Arusha

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch

Early breakfast, followed by the descent into the Ngorongoro Crater.

A half-day game drive covering different habitats within the crater. Wildlife density is high, with strong chances of seeing lion, buffalo, zebra, hippo and elephant. Black rhino may also be seen, though not guaranteed.

Picnic lunch inside the crater. In the afternoon, ascend and return to Arusha.

Pricing

Prices are per person and depend on the number of travellers in your group. Smaller groups carry a supplement, as the vehicle, guide and crater fees are shared across fewer people.

Your safari starts and ends in Arusha.

We collect you from your hotel in Arusha on the morning of Day 1 and drop you back there at the end of the safari.
