

5-Day Tarangire, Serengeti, Ngorongoro & Lake Manyara Safari

Detailed Day-by-Day Itinerary

Day 1 — Arusha → Tarangire National Park

Drive approx. 2–3 hours | Meals: Lunch, Dinner

Morning pickup in Arusha and the drive to Tarangire National Park, arriving by late morning to begin the game drive.

The park is characterised by wide savannah, scattered acacia woodland and large baobab trees. Wildlife activity is often concentrated along the Tarangire River. The game drive continues through midday, with a picnic lunch inside the park.

In the afternoon, continue exploring different sections of the park before exiting toward Karatu or Mto wa Mbu.

Overnight: Mid-range lodge or tented camp

Day 2 — Karatu → Serengeti National Park

Long driving day | Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Early breakfast and departure toward the Serengeti via the Ngorongoro Conservation Area. The drive passes through highland terrain before descending onto the Serengeti plains.

Travel time is long, so this day focuses on the transfer combined with game viewing en route. The game drive begins on entering the Serengeti in the afternoon, with sightings that may include lion, giraffe, elephant, zebra and herds across the open plains.

Game viewing continues toward the campsite, arriving before sunset.

Overnight: Mid-range lodge or tented camp

Day 3 — Full Day in the Serengeti

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

A full day of game driving. Depart camp after breakfast and spend the day exploring different areas depending on wildlife movement. The open plains allow for wide visibility and consistent sightings.

Break for picnic lunch during the day, then continue game drives through the afternoon. Return to camp in the evening.

Overnight: Mid-range lodge or tented camp

Day 4 — Serengeti → Ngorongoro Crater → Karatu

Long day | Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Breakfast at camp, then departure from the Serengeti. Game viewing continues during the drive out of the park, as sightings are still common along the route.

Proceed toward the Ngorongoro Conservation Area and descend into the crater for a half-day game drive. The crater floor allows efficient wildlife viewing within a shorter time. Expect lion, buffalo, zebra, hippo and elephant, with a possibility of black rhino.

Picnic lunch inside the crater. In the afternoon, ascend and continue to Karatu.

Overnight: Mid-range lodge or tented camp

Day 5 — Lake Manyara → Arusha

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch

Breakfast and a short transfer to Lake Manyara National Park.

The game drive covers a compact but varied landscape, including groundwater forest, open plains and lakeside areas. Wildlife may include elephant, hippo, monkeys and giraffe, alongside a wide range of birdlife. Tree-climbing lions are present but not guaranteed.

Picnic lunch inside the park. Exit in the afternoon and return to Arusha.

Pricing

Prices are per person and depend on the number of travellers in your group. Smaller groups carry a supplement, as the vehicle, guide and crater fees are shared across fewer people.
